The Artist

At the age of 20, he moved to Milan, where, alongside significant professional growth, he began working closely with industrial and artisanal software and technologies, experimenting with them in the artistic field. He primarily established himself as an interior designer, a position that allowed him to emerge as an eclectic artist.

Following a series of personal and collective exhibitions, one of his notable artistic experiences was participating in the prestigious International Art Festival in August 2013, in the Polish Loire Valley, where he was a guest alongside other great figures from around the world, including Oscar-winning director Zbigniew Rybczyński and photographer Ryszard Horowitz.

In 2014, he was selected for the Biennale della Creatività in Verona, directed by Paolo Levi and inaugurated by Vittorio Sgarbi.

In the following years, he dedicated himself full-time, as Creative Director, to the development of his company MIGLIORINO® Design Atelier, operating in the high-end furniture and decorative coverings sector. The company distinguished itself from the start in the market, earning numerous recognitions and important awards, including one during the 79th Venice Film Festival for creating a "Design Capsule Collection with actor Ronn Moss" in 2022 and recognition as "Excellences of Italy" in 2023.

His entrepreneurial commitments did not detract from his passion for art; he continued to design new works for the future that would mark a turning point towards the symbiosis between material and digital art. Additionally, he is working on the "ADAMO2030 Project" with the sponsorship of the Puglia Region, which sees his sculpture Adamo 2030 traveling the world, accompanied by other art forms such as music and literature, with the aim of raising awareness on environmental protection and raising funds for specialized entities on the topic.

Until 2010, I would have never imagined finding myself here, describing why I make art and what I want to express when creating a piece, even though from a very young age, I have always shown a lot of creativity, manifesting it in various mostly unconventional ways.

I didn't have an artistic education and I never showed particular interest in the academic art world, so I always thought that, to be considered an "artist," it was necessary to somehow have a certificate from that kind of world. However, I have always lived art spontaneously, showing a genuine interest in everything related to creative expression.

Today I realize that this "free" path allowed me to find my own language and pushed me to experiment independently with different solutions, finding in each one an independent expression.

I have always been attracted to the most intrinsic meaning of the term "create"; I have always been fascinated by the act itself of generating something from nothing, in any artistic field, as well as the desire to find art in everything. Until I was able to understand which "medium" was most suitable for me, I simply gave free rein to my inspiration in various ways, writing texts, composing music, drawing, painting, and much more, until I discovered the digital world, the key with which I opened my universe.

This relentless search made me realize that I had to make art my life. I started with work, following my other great passion, interior design, initially dealing with interior design and then founding a company that bears my name and offers exclusive design products. At the same time, I have always continued to create and experiment with new techniques, often borrowed from the industrial world. If initially material experimentation and aesthetic value dominated the meaning of my works, today the concept is the master, the material and technical aspect are more of a vehicle to achieve the result I aim for.

However, every work today has its embryo in a work from the early years or even earlier, in a thought from childhood. For me, this means coherence; it means that the values I want to express have always been the same.

Work, family, the society in which I live, are all microcosms that make me reflect, make me think, and lead me to create. Whether willingly or unwillingly, we all participate in each other's lives, and superficiality, a concept opposed to beauty, should not be contemplated: my works, especially those of recent years, go in this direction, they aim to reach everyone's conscience, try to stimulate and reach people who ask themselves questions.

Another aspect that I consider of primary importance is technology and how it makes its presence felt in our daily lives: here too my goal is to stimulate, ask questions, not take anything for granted.

However, what I want to emphasize is that I do not intend to provide answers because I don't have them: what I try to do is urge and encourage the viewer to critically assess life and invite the latter to search for anything that makes them better.

The reason why I make art today is completely selfish; I feel the need for it, I am thirsty for knowledge, many topics fascinate me, especially everything concerning the human capacity to create and achieve. After delving into a topic or experiencing something, I feel an irresistible need to express myself; my thought processes images and sets in motion a creative process that can last a long time or may fade away only to return much later, even stronger. Only when I am able to visualize the idea do I elaborate it definitively. It's like a compulsion that absolutely needs an outlet.

For the future, I don't feel like excluding any artistic medium; I definitely want to continue asking questions and encouraging others to do the same, especially I want to contribute to eliminating the pervasive negativity that all too often takes over our lives.





The artwork is inspired by the manilla, the currency used during the slave trade, to reflect on modern oppressions. The manilla no longer circulates today, but humanity has not freed itself from other forms of slavery: the rope that wraps around the figures is like a noose that binds them in a condition (concrete or mental) of subjugation to the "choices" imposed by society. However, the rope has no knots: humanity autonomously binds itself to the apathy of its comfort zone, without taking actions of freedom. Only the child is free from any type of bond because it is not yet subjected to external influences.






Mother for ever














Provocations

Giraffa 200x125x230h cm Series of Sculptures / Series of Digital Sculptures NFT

This sculpture is the first in a series dedicated to animals facing extinction due to human activities. The contrast between the pure white and the glossy gold highlights the innocence of the animal and its priceless value to the Earth's ecosystem. The swing held in the animal's mouth seems to invite the observer to a carefree game, but it conceals a deeper message: the dry branch symbolizes the tragedy of deforestation, while the rope encircling it evokes the constant threat of poaching, emphasizing the fragility of their existence.

This sculpture is the second piece in the series dedicated to animals on the brink of extinction due to human activities. The contrast between the pure white enveloping the lion and the glossy gold details—the tuft of its tail and its claws—highlights the duality between the innocence of this magnificent animal and its priceless value to the Earth's ecosystem.

The majestic lion is playfully crouched on a golden carpet. It holds two puzzle pieces in its jaws, unaware of the profound significance of the golden puzzle beneath it. The puzzle, made of gleaming pieces, outlines the shape of Africa, symbolizing the continent that embodies the greatest expression of natural beauty while simultaneously being the stage for some of the most destructive human activities against nature.

Some pieces of the puzzle are slowly melting, like snow under the sun, symbolizing the gradual loss of the lion's natural habitat. The animal's innocent gesture of playing with what is being lost, combined with the brilliance of its golden claws, evokes a sense of both preciousness and fragility. The artwork thus becomes a powerful metaphor for human responsibility in preserving an increasingly fragile natural balance, inviting the viewer to reflect on the urgent need to act in order to protect what we are dangerously close to losing forever.

This sculpture is the third piece in the series dedicated to animals on the brink of extinction due to human activities. The contrast between the pure white enveloping the rhinoceros and the glossy gold detail of its horns highlights the imposing strength and priceless value of this animal, a symbol of resilience and vulnerability.

The rhinoceros is depicted with its head lowered and front legs spread wide, as if sniffing the ground, yet it is innocently engaged in a game: its powerful horn becomes the target of a ring-toss game. Four golden rings, crafted from braided rope and barbed wire, are perfectly centered on the horn, while others lie scattered on the ground, symbolizing failed attempts.

This ironic and surreal representation transforms the emblem of its survival—the horn, for which it is brutally hunted—into an object of play, symbolizing both the innocence of the animal and the cruelty of human actions. The piece invites the viewer to reflect on the contradiction between the rhinoceros's physical power and the fragility of its existence, threatened by poaching and habitat destruction.

The innocence of the gesture, coupled with the contrast between the purity of the white and the symbolic harshness of the golden barbed wire, makes the sculpture a powerful metaphor for human responsibility, demanding an end to the destructive "game" that is leading to the loss of these majestic creatures.

Gorilla 140x100x120h cm Series of Sculptures / Series of Digital Sculptures NFT

This sculpture is the fourth piece in the series dedicated to animals on the brink of extinction due to human activities. The contrast between the pure white enveloping the gorilla and the glossy gold accents on its face, chest, and claws highlights the duality between its formidable strength and its deep vulnerability.

The gorilla is depicted in a moment of innocent play, sitting as it carefully assembles a rocking horse made entirely of golden bullet casings. Piece by piece, it stacks the casings with a thoughtful yet naive curiosity, unaware of the sinister symbolism they hold. What appears to be a simple act of construction becomes a poignant reflection on the transformation of violence into a game—an eerie parallel to the real threats these animals face in the wild.

This surreal representation subverts expectations, turning objects of destruction into elements of play. The gorilla, an icon of intelligence and raw power, unwittingly engages with the very force that threatens its survival. The artwork invites the viewer to contemplate the tragic irony of this contrast, highlighting the devastating impact of poaching and habitat loss on one of nature's most extraordinary beings.

The purity of the white form against the gleaming gold of the bullet casings underscores the precious yet fragile existence of the species. This sculpture stands as a powerful metaphor for the urgent need to rethink our role in protecting these creatures before their fate is sealed—not by nature, but by human hands.

At a quick and superficial glance, we all seem to wear the same garment and live the same lives... but this is precisely the reflection the work aims to convey: it is the very differences in the details that, in some way, make us equal.







Sculpture in laser-cut stainless steel, on a handcrafted resin surface.


3duard emerges from the resin surface coming to life, a life in steel that with its intrinsic strength tears through the panel and forcefully comes to light.
